

Watercolours

This course is suitable for beginner and intermediate levels and will be taught through demonstrations and examples, 1:1 help when necessary and time will be made to appreciate other's achievements.

The course aims to develop your enjoyment and appreciation of watercolour. You will be taught pure watercolour techniques, colour mixing and the use of watercolour with other media. Varied subject matter and starting points will provide opportunities to use a range of techniques and develop your visual imagination.

Please bring your own watercolour materials including a palette and 2 small water pots, a pad of drawing paper and a soft pencil will be needed for sketches. Some paper is available to purchase in the art room

We are currently implementing certain criteria to meet Government guidelines, regarding Covid19 and in order to keep safe, the following will apply:

- It will be mandatory to wear a face mask, unless you have a specified medical reason not to
- Your temperature will be taken before entry to the building
