

## Repeat Pattern Linoprint

### Who is the course for?

- Beginners
- Those with some printmaking experience and want a refresher
- Those who have attended a linoprinting class and want to try repeated pattern printing

### How will the course be taught?

- Group demonstrations
- Individual tuition when needed

### Course content;

- Learn how to design, cut, register and print a single colour, repeated linoprint
- Learn how to design a seamless repeatable pattern
- Learners will be shown how to safely use and maintain equipment and will achieve prints on paper
- Please note these techniques require a moderate level of dexterity and hand/ arm strength. If you are concerned please contact the centre, but the Tutor will be able to support and assist as much as possible

### Equipment;

- All specialist equipment and materials will be provided
- Plain paper will be provided. Sadly we do not have provisions to print on fabric
- Please bring a couple of images you would like to draw your design from. You can use images from the internet, a sketch or a book. If you are unable to do this, there will be images provided
- Please wear old clothes or bring an apron

Please note the surfaces we will work with are reflective. If you struggle to see or focus on this type of material please contact us to discuss the course (below).
