

## Collograph Printmaking

**Who is the course for?**

- Beginners
- Those who have some experience with printmaking

**How will the course be taught?**

- Group demonstrations
- Individual tuition when needed

**Course content:**

Over two sessions you will learn how to print a collograph print. You will learn how to design and create several textured printing plates, using different collage materials. You will learn how to properly ink your printing plate and then print from your designs. Learners will achieve single colour prints using a printing press as well as by hand.

**Equipment and materials provided:**

All specialist equipment and materials will be provided.

Plain paper will be provided.

**Equipment you need to bring:**

- Basic stationary (a pencil, rubber, pen)
- You may wish to bring a selection of textured collage materials such as raised wallpaper, old fabric, netting (if not, a selection will be provided.)
- Some images you'd like to work from. This could be a photograph or work by an artist. We will work in basic and graphic shapes. If you wish to design an image beforehand, your prints will be approximately A5 to A4.
- An apron or old clothes
- A pair of rubber gloves to avoid staining your hands
