

## Stained Glass Weekend Workshop

**Dates:** Saturday 26/06/21 & Sunday 27/06/21

**Times:** 10:00-16:00

This is an intensive course on how to make a simple stained glass panel no bigger than A5 size.

Please bring;

- a few designs ideas and patterns from which you can select one design
- a cloth apron
- pad and pencil
- please wear enclosed shoes
- lunch and refreshments

Please note there will be an additional materials charge of approximately £20.00, depending on design

### **Saturday:**

During the morning you will be shown how to cut glass safely and accurately using specialist equipment and introduced to the two methods of assembly (lead & copper foil). Having chosen your design the rest of the day is spent cutting glass to your design. Also you may start assembling your panel.

### **Sunday:**

Continuing with cutting and assembling after which you will solder together the panel. When completed leaded panels will be cemented while copper foil ones will have a patina applied. All of the projects will have rings applied so that they may be hung in a window.

We are currently implementing certain criteria to meet Government guidelines, regarding Covid19 and in order to keep safe, the following will apply:

- It will be mandatory to wear a face mask, unless you have a specified medical reason not to
- Different entry and exit doors will be in operation
- Sanitise your hands on entry.
- Hot drinks will not be available – please bring your own flask
- We will ask people to stay in their classrooms where possible
- Please adhere to the 1 metre rule where you can
- Class sizes will have to be smaller
- Where possible sharing of equipment will be kept to a minimum and sanitised between individual use, we encourage you to bring your own equipment to the class

We ask that you do not arrive to your class more than 10 minutes prior to the start time. Please be assured that the classrooms are sanitised after each class.

Norma Wall has been teaching for some years. She gained her degree in Ceramics and Stained Glass at Edinburgh College of Art. She exhibits her work, has won National Awards and still makes projects for clients.
