Who is the course for?

- Absolute beginners
- Those with some printmaking experience and want a refresher.
- More experienced students are welcome to join the class and work independently using the studio,

How will the course be taught?

- Group demonstrations
- Individual tuition when needed

Course content:

Create a set of festive prints to be mounted onto cards, or art prints suitable for framing.

- Learn how to do drypoint etching using an etching needle. You will get to try two types of etching plate.
- Learn how to prepare your paper for printing on the press.
- Learn how to use the press safely.

Please note the surfaces we will work with are reflective. If you struggle to see or focus on this type of material please contact us to discuss the course (below).

Equipment and materials:

All specialist equipment and materials will be provided.

Plain paper will be provided. Sadly we do not have provisions to print on fabric.

Please bring a selection of simple black and white images (100mm x 143mm) you would like to work from. If you are unable to do this, there will be images provided.
