This one day workshop aims to teach students how to use water soluble sticks that they may already have or are interested in trying. Students will explore how to use them and combine them with other watercolour mediums.

- Plenty of reasonable quality watercolour paper
- A good selection of brushes
- Pastels
- Watercolours (including any Inktense product and watercolour pencils)
- Any water soluble sticks you may have
