Who is the workshop suitable for?

- Absolute beginners
- Those with experience
- Christmas lovers, particularly homemade Christmas fans!

How will it be taught?

- Group demonstrations
- 1:1 guidance (as appropriate)

What to expect:

This adult learner taster workshop aims to introduce participants to the craft of macramé and inspire participants to explore further the creativity that macramé can offer. This workshop is suitable for beginners. We will spend some time mastering some basic Macramé knots in order to make your very own macramé Christmas decorations – starting with a wreath and moving onto other decorations as time permits.

You may need to complete some of your projects at home – you will have gained the skills required during the workshop and full instructions will be provided.

It is for anyone who has never tried macramé before and wishes to gain a taste of this craft, as well as for those who may have tried macramé in the past and want to brush up on their basic or forgotten skills.

Equipment and materials:

- All specialist equipment and materials will be provided
- Textile scissors
- Pen
- Notebook
- Clean plastic comb
