About the workshop;

This is an advanced masterclass, suitable for those with sewing experience.

This workshop will look at the fly zipper, which is a useful zip application for trousers, jeans, and casual skirts.

This class will teach you how to insert it neatly with a professional finish.

You will make a sample to take home for future reference.

You will need to bring a 7 inch zip, pins, thread, and a marking tool (ie. Chalk) and a pen.

You may use a machine supplied by the centre or bring your own machine.

The classroom will be well ventilated, with open windows, additional layers may be necessary.
