### Course Information & Teaching Methods;

The tutor will be on hand to guide and develop your learning and understanding of life drawing. The course will be taught by tutor demonstrations, 1:1 guidance and tutor handouts.

This term we will be exploring line drawing and watercolour washes

### Information;

Please bring the following to each class:

- Selection of water-soluble coloured pencils
- Drawing paper and watercolour paper. Drawing paper and watercolour paper can be purchased at the Centre
- Own hard board where possible, to be taken home after each session
- Selection of watercolour paint, tubes or pans.
- Selection of watercolour brushes, no 4. No 8, no 10.
- A small rag cloth (old tea towel etc..) and watercolour paint plate/tray mixing, alternately yoghurt pots are also good

The selection of the watercolour equipment can be further discussed on the first session

Tea, coffee and biscuits are available in the kitchen area, for a small charge.
